There are a number of technical “speed bumps” in our way to streamlining the complete dataflow needed to deliver high-quality, always-working smart e-services within the infrastructure domain, especially when taking the multi-modal infrastructure view.

No smart e-services will reach the required level of quality if the base data is not made available, in such a way that it is easy accessible, and with a known level of quality. Changes occur all the time; new roads are built, roads are temporarily or permanently closed, road lane configuration changes, turning patterns in a junction, etc. We will look at the INSPIRE directive as one of the major technical solutions for achieving smart e-service. Does INSPIRE actually solve it all?
